Proposed Ride Sharing Tax

- *New \$2 tax per ride*
- *No tax in place now*
- *Goal is to raise revenue*

Where did the input data come from?

Data on the Ride Sharing Market

- *Current cost of a ride*
- *Brief description of Alphaville survey*
- *Table with demographic details about Alphaville riders and number of rides taken*
- *Brief description of Betatown policy and outcomes*
- *Note key assumption that Alphaville riders will behave in the same way*

What did you find and why should the reader believe you?

Impact on Riders

- *Use Betaville percentage changes to infer new Alphaville rides per capita*
- *Tax revenue per rider*
- *Effective tax rate for riders in each group*
- *Table summarizing results*
- *Progressivity or regressivity*
- *Total impact on rider welfare (e.g., change in consumer surplus)*

Impact on Drivers

- *Percentage change in total number of rides*
- *Note implication of fewer drivers or fewer rides per driver or a mix*
- *Total impact on driver welfare (e.g., change in producer surplus)*

Impact on Government Revenue

- *Total revenue raised*
- *Welfare cost of the revenue (e.g., deadweight loss)*

Very short list of key findings

- *Revenue raised*
- *Progressivity or regressivity*
- *Overall welfare cost*
- *Caveat about similarity to Betaville*
