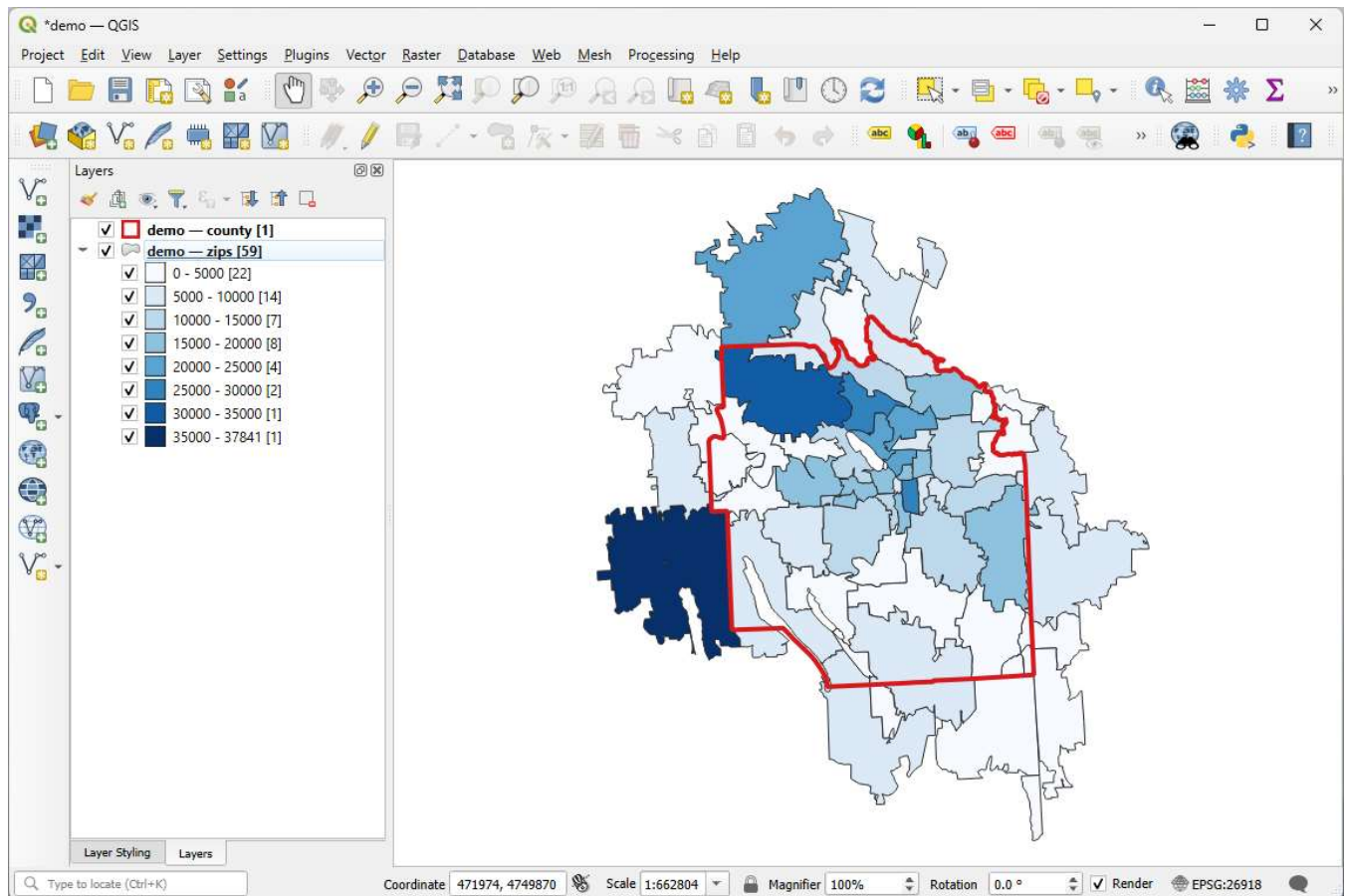

Can add legends, text, and other information

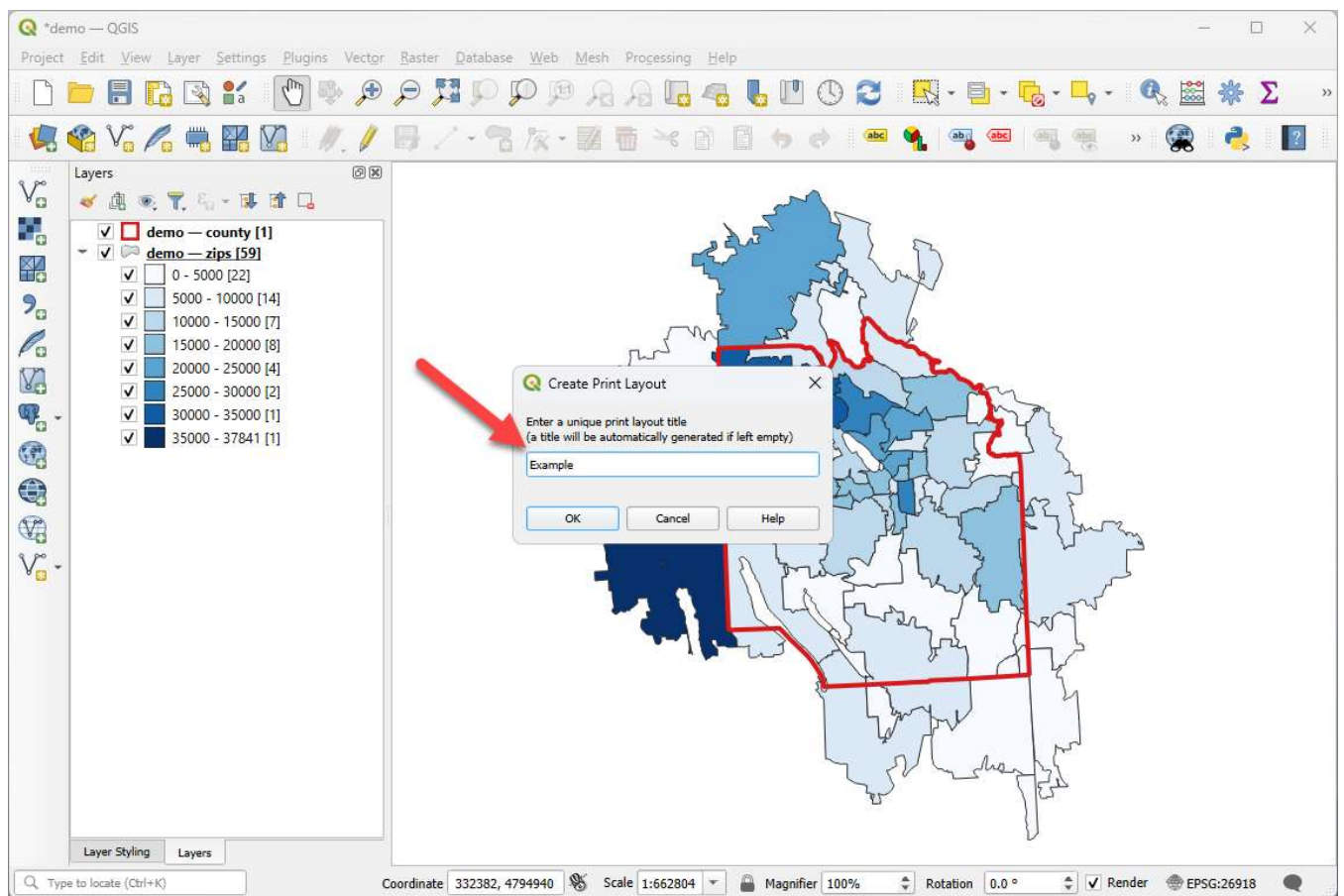
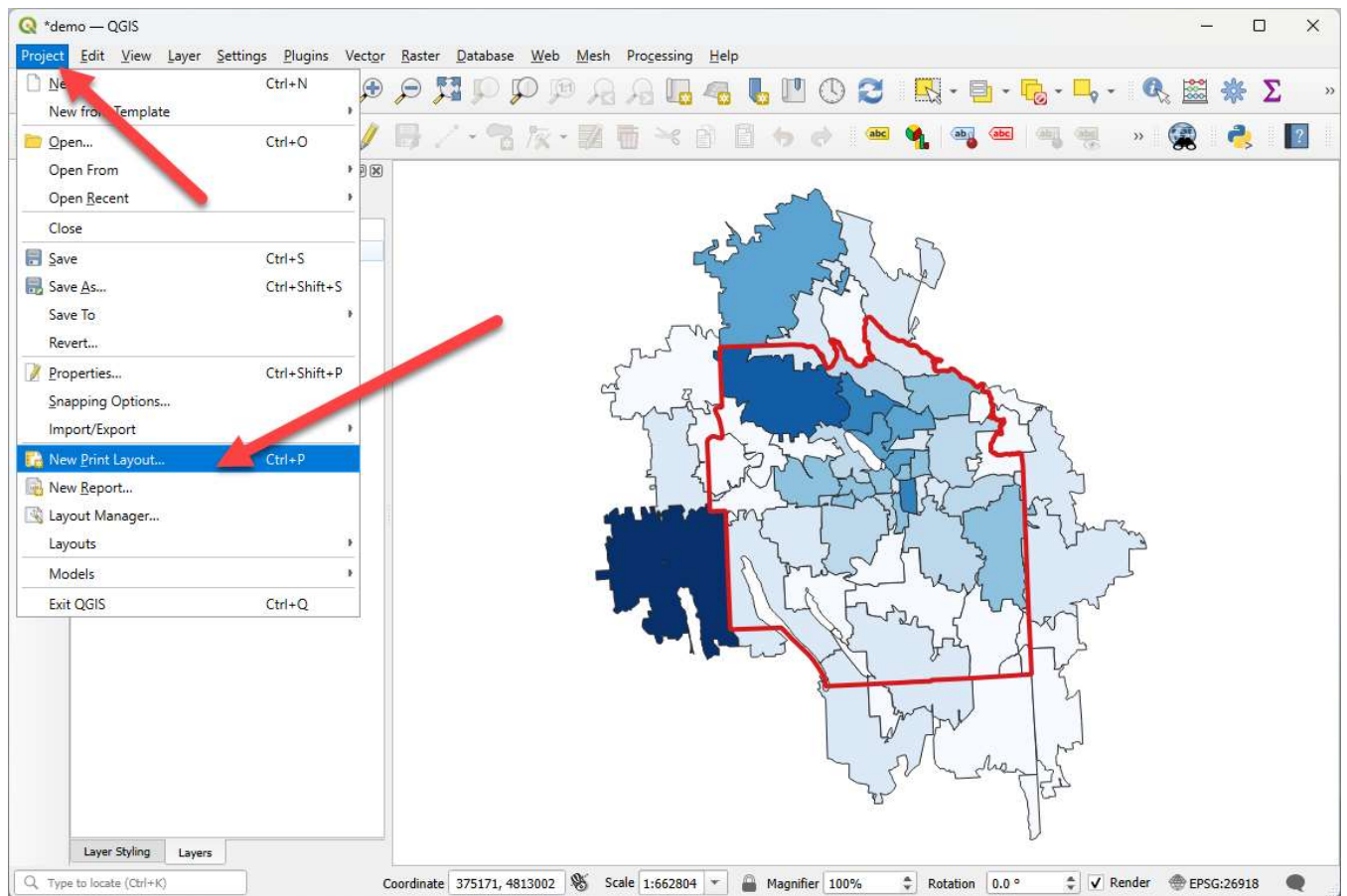
Construct but dragging, dropping, and modifying map elements.

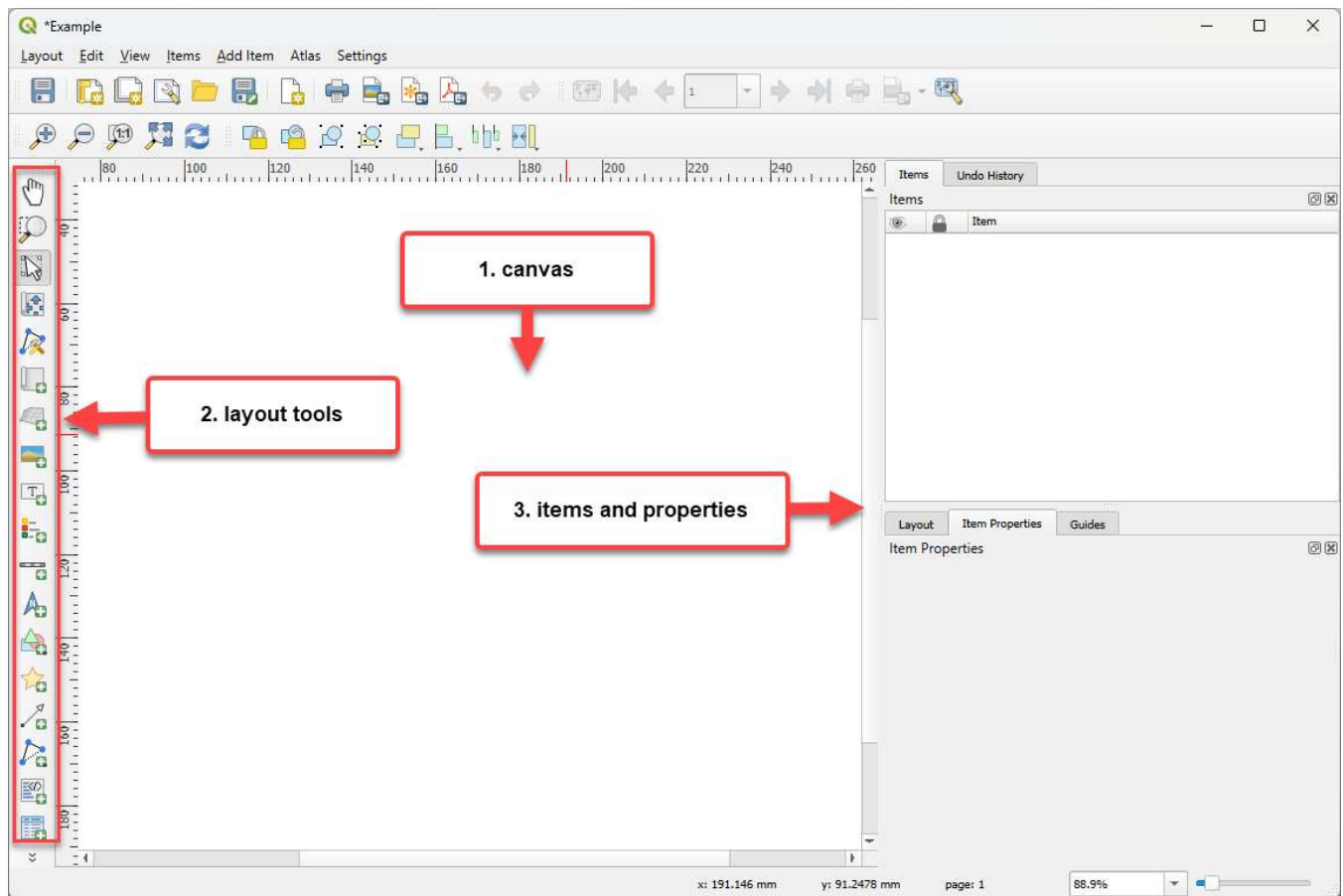
### Example: population by zip code in Central New York



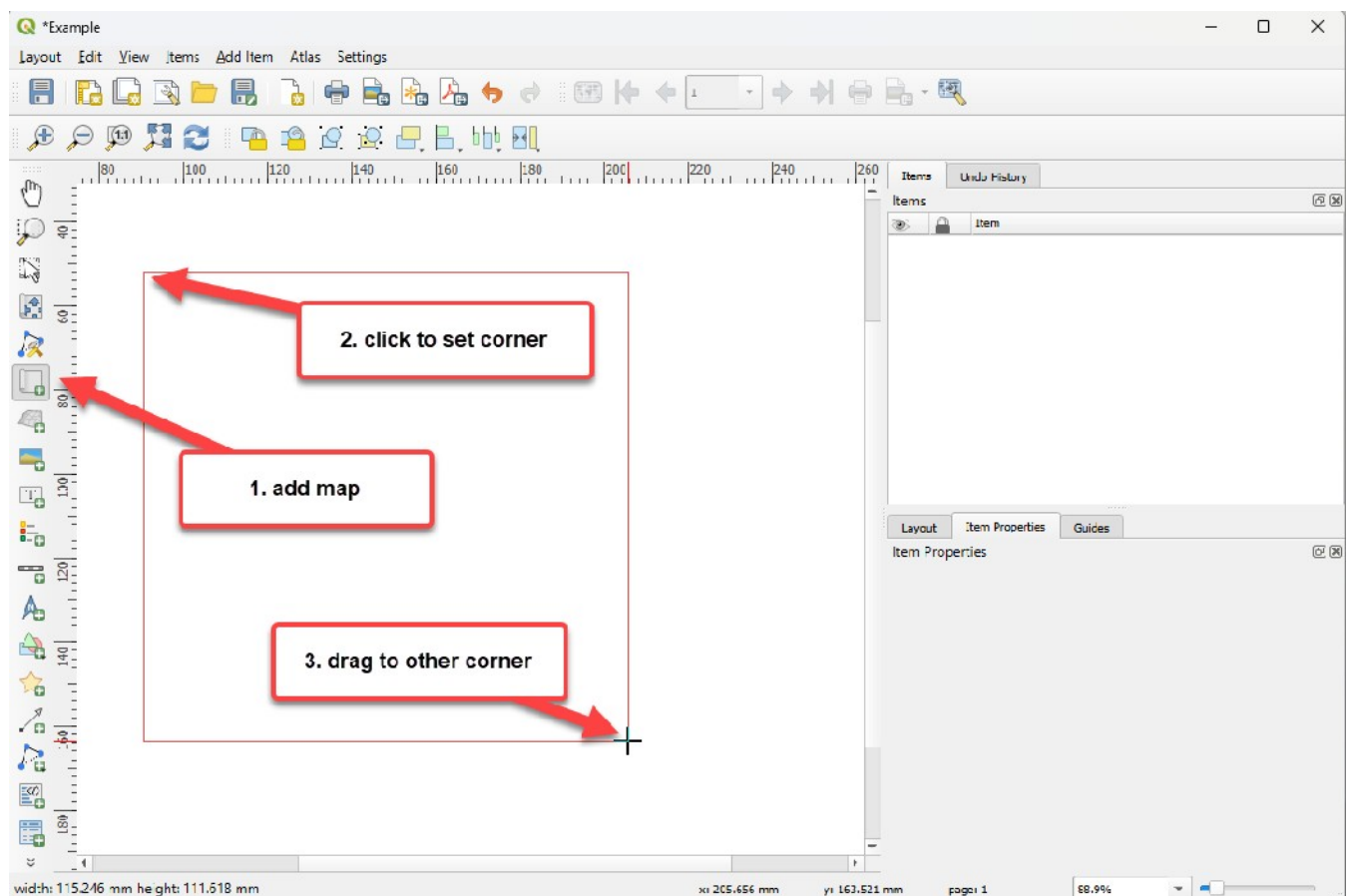

1. select legend

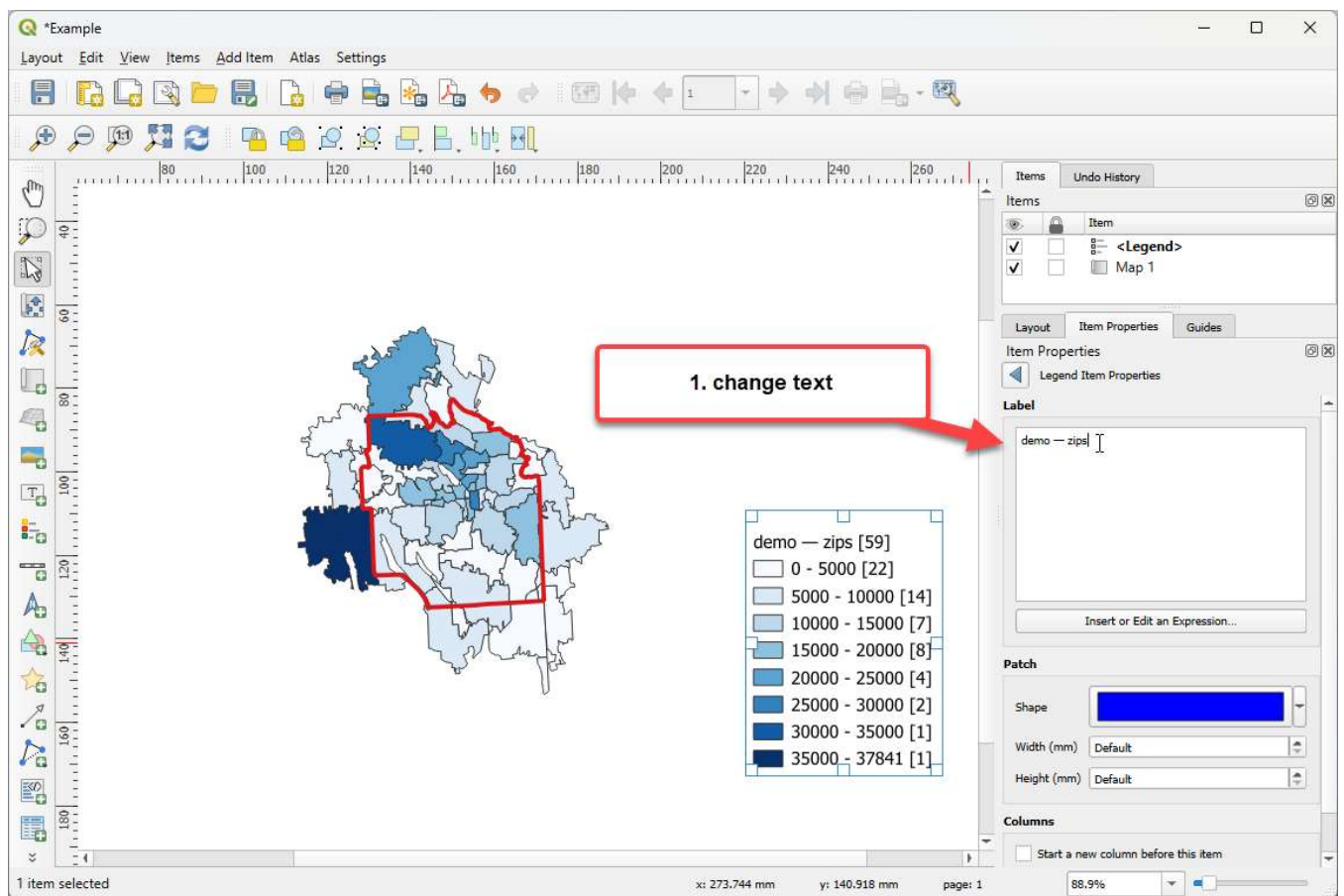
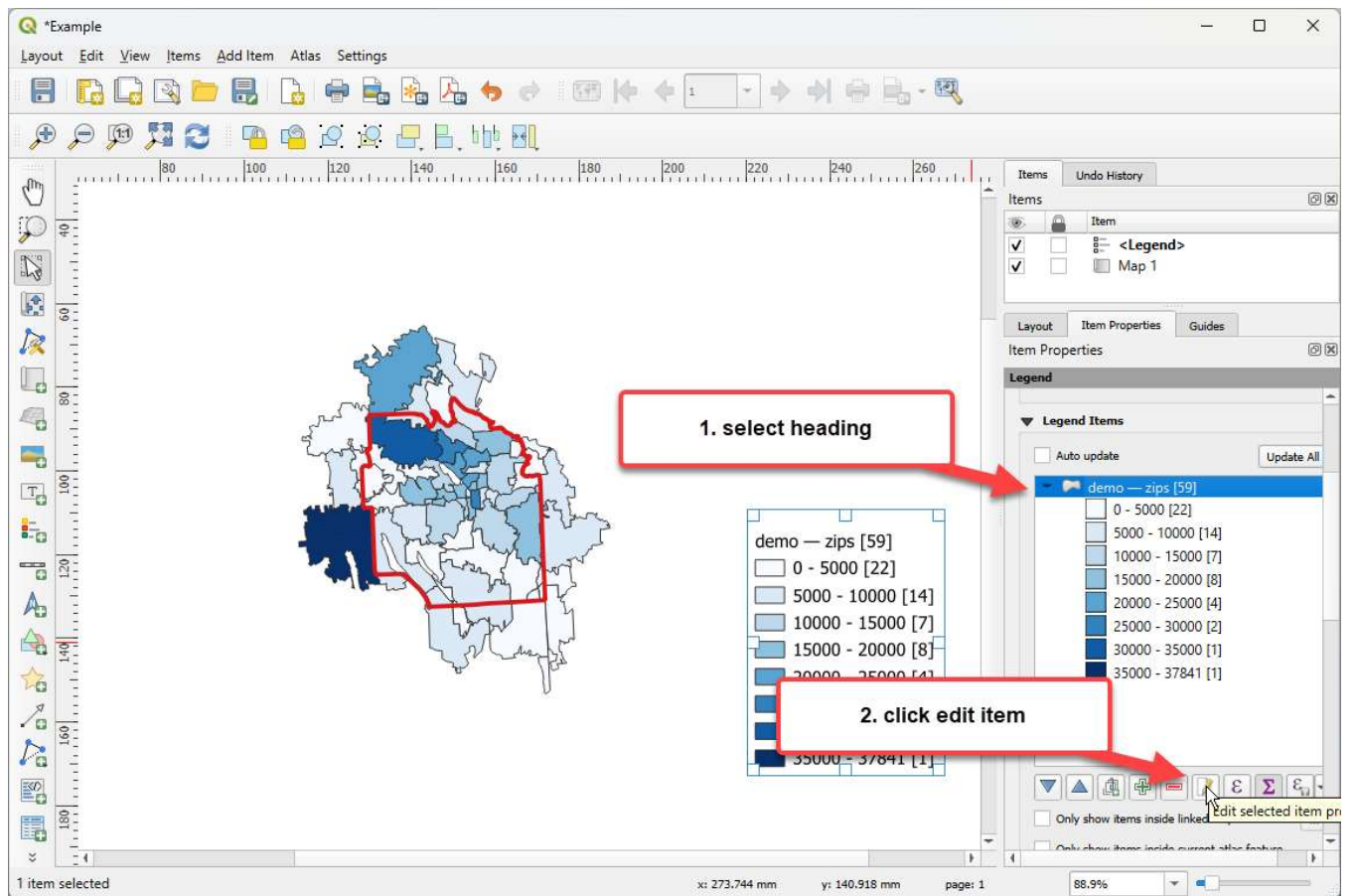
2. select county boundary
